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

Institute for the Care of Mother and Child

- Largest perinatal center
- Number of births over 5000 per year
- Over 160 births of VLBW (BW < 1500g), ELBW cca 50
- Large number of high risk newborns (e.g.reference center for CDH and monochorionic twins - Fetal Therapy Center)

Aimes and Activities of the Projects

Improvement of follow-up care for inborn high risk newborns

- Nursing and medical staff education
- Aquisition of new medical intruments used in long term (neurosensoric functions examination optimalisation)
- Outpatient clinic reconstruction (multidisciplinary team)
- Specification of risk groups
- New guidelines and follow-up algorithm



Oslo University Hospital NICU



Rikshospitalet NICU:

- 20 beds
- 10 intensive care
- 10 special care

Ullevål NICU:

- 27 beds
- 7 intensive care
- 20 special care

The NICU at OUS:

- drains 54 % of Norwegian deliveries (63 000) as a regional unit
- approximately 1500 annual admissions
- national responsibilities
